Do you see the sovereign hand of God at work when you meet a person from another country? Since our last letter God arranged for us to meet several Japanese people. How cool is that! Shin is a Japanese young man studying abroad here in the USA. Terumi is a Japanese lady that has moved here. We were able to share why we are going to Japan with both of them. It is a misunderstanding to think that we are not ministering because we are busy raising support in the USA. We are ministering both to Americans and Japanese alike! Your monthly partnership with us makes this possible.

I'd like to share a little about Terumi. Like most Japanese families, hers has a Buddhist ancestry. However, her parents became dissatisfied with Buddhism and searched for a different religion. She ended up coming to the United States where she heard the gospel and believed. We praise God that he brought her to the United States for that purpose, but most Japanese people will never come to the United States. And in Japan most will never hear the gospel a single time.

The Lord brought us one step closer to taking the gospel to unreached people in Japan since our last newsletter. Before we can take the gospel to Japan there are several milestones that need to be accomplished.

The first milestone that needed to be accomplished was to partner with a mission service center that could help us process mail and donations. The
